- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 264.109(a), Family Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Section 264.763, the [The]
- 8 placement of a child in substitute care by the department
- 9 constitutes an assignment to the state of any support rights
- 10 attributable to the child as of the date the child is placed in
- 11 substitute care.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter I, Chapter 264, Family Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Section 264.763 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 264.763. PAYMENT OF CHILD'S SUPPORT RIGHTS AND
- 15 BENEFITS. A relative or other designated caregiver is eligible to
- 16 receive support and benefits, including monthly benefits, on behalf
- 17 of a child placed with the person by the department. The department
- 18 shall pass through to the relative or other designated caregiver:
- 19 (1) any support rights attributable to the child; and
- 20 (2) payments to which the child is entitled or that are
- 21 paid for the benefit of the child, including Supplemental Security
- 22 Income (SSI) benefits under 42 U.S.C. Section 1381 et seq.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
