A relative or other designated caregiver is eligible to 15 16 receive support and benefits on behalf of a child placed with the person by the department. The department shall facilitate: 17 18 (1) the assignment to the relative or other designated caregiver of any support rights attributable to the child; and 19 (2) the designation of the relative or other 20 21 designated caregiver as the representative payee for any programs, services, and payments to which the child is entitled or that are 22 23 paid for the benefit of the child, including Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits under 42 U.S.C. Section 1381 et seq. 24
