A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a pilot program to provide grants for free or
3	reduced-tuition prekindergarten classes to certain children.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 29.1535 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 29.1535. FREE AND REDUCED-TUITION PREKINDERGARTEN
8	GRANT PILOT PROGRAM. (a) From money appropriated or otherwise
9	available for the purpose, the commissioner, in collaboration with
10	the Pre-K 4 SA early childhood initiative, shall establish and
11	administer a pilot program to provide grants to school districts,
12	open-enrollment charter schools, and private schools to provide
13	free or reduced-tuition prekindergarten classes to eligible
14	children.
15	(b) A school district, open-enrollment charter school, or
16	private school shall use money received under the pilot program to
17	provide free or reduced-tuition prekindergarten classes to
18	eligible children.
19	(c) A child is eligible to enroll in a prekindergarten class
20	described by Subsection (b) if the child:
21	(1) is at least three years of age; and
22	(2) resides in the regional boundaries of the Region

20 education service center.

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(d) To the extent consistent with state and federal law, a

- 1 prekindergarten class provided using money received under the pilot
- 2 program must be operated in accordance with any curriculum and
- 3 teaching methods implemented by the Pre-K 4 SA early childhood
- 4 initiative.
- 5 (e) Not later than September 1 of each year, the
- 6 commissioner shall prepare and submit to the legislature a report
- 7 on the pilot program under this section. The report must include:
- 8 (1) an evaluation of the academic and developmental
- 9 achievements of students enrolled in a prekindergarten class using
- 10 money received under the pilot program; and
- 11 (2) any recommendations for legislative or other
- 12 action.
- 13 (f) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 14 establish and administer the pilot program under this section.
- 15 (g) The pilot program is abolished and this section expires
- 16 January 1, 2031.
- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2026, the
- 18 commissioner of education shall submit the initial report required
- 19 by Section 29.1535, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
