A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a state employment preference for certain individuals
- 3 who reside with veterans with a disability.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 657.002, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 657.002. INDIVIDUALS QUALIFIED FOR MILITARY
- 8 EMPLOYMENT PREFERENCE. The following individuals qualify for a
- 9 military employment preference:
- 10 (1) a veteran, including a veteran with a disability;
- 11 (2) a veteran's surviving spouse who has not
- 12 remarried;
- 13 (3) an orphan of a veteran if the veteran was killed
- 14 while on active duty;
- 15 (4) the spouse of a member of the United States armed
- 16 forces or Texas National Guard serving on active duty; [and]
- 17 (5) the spouse of a veteran if the spouse is the
- 18 primary source of income for the household and the veteran has a
- 19 total disability rating based either on having a service-connected
- 20 disability with a disability rating of at least 70 percent or on
- 21 individual unemployability; and
- 22 (6) an individual who resides in a household with a
- 23 veteran if the individual is the primary source of income for the
- 24 household and the veteran:

- 1 (A) has a total disability rating based either on
- 2 having a service-connected disability with a disability rating of
- 3 100 percent or on individual unemployability; and
- 4 (B) is receiving Supplemental Security Income
- 5 (SSI) benefits under 42 U.S.C. Section 1381 et seq. or Social
- 6 Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits under 42 U.S.C.
- 7 <u>Section 401 et seq</u>.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 657.003(b), Government Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 (b) A state agency shall provide to an individual entitled
- 11 to a military employment preference for employment or appointment
- 12 over other applicants for the same position who do not have a
- 13 greater qualification a military employment preference, in the
- 14 following order of priority:
- 15 (1) a veteran with a disability;
- 16 (2) a veteran;
- 17 (3) a spouse described by Section 657.002(4) or (5);
- 18 (4) a veteran's surviving spouse who has not
- 19 remarried; [and]
- 20 (5) an orphan of a veteran if the veteran was killed
- 21 while on active duty; and
- 22 (6) an individual who resides with a veteran with a
- 23 disability as described by Section 657.002(6) if the individual is
- 24 the primary source of income for the veteran's household.
- 25 SECTION 3. Section 657.005(b), Government Code, is amended
- 26 to read as follows:
- 27 (b) An applicant who is a veteran with a disability, a

- 1 spouse of a veteran as described by Section 657.002(5), or an
- 2 <u>individual</u> who resides with a veteran with a disability as
- 3 described by Section 657.002(6) if the individual is the primary
- 4 source of income for the veteran's household, shall furnish the
- 5 official records to the individual whose duty is to fill the
- 6 position.
- 7 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 an open position with a state agency for which the state agency
- 9 begins accepting applications on or after the effective date of
- 10 this Act. An open position with a state agency for which the state
- 11 agency begins accepting applications before the effective date of
- 12 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the state
- 13 agency began accepting applications, and the former law is
- 14 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
