- SECTION 2. Section 42.06(b), Penal Code, is amended to read 13

- (b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor, 15
- 16 except that the offense is:
- (1) a state jail felony if [unless] the false report is 17
- of an emergency involving [a public or private institution of 18
- higher education or involving a public primary or secondary 19

- 21 water, gas, or power supply or other public service; or
- 22 (2) a felony of the third degree if the false report is

- 2 (B) a public or private primary or secondary
- 3 school [, in which event the offense is a state jail felony].
- 4 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 5 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 7 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 8 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 9 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 10 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 11 committed before that date.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
