7 CHAPTER 100B. LIABILITY FOR DISCRIMINATION

- 8 Sec. 100B.001. LIABILITY FOR DISCRIMINATORY FALSE REPORTS
- 9 TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AND EMERGENCY SERVICE PROVIDERS. (a) A
- 10 person who submits a false report to a law enforcement agency or
- 11 emergency service provider, with the intent that the law
- 12 enforcement agency or emergency service provider take action
- 13 against a falsely accused person, is liable to the falsely accused
- 14 person for an amount not to exceed \$250 if the report was submitted
- 15 due to bias or prejudice against the falsely accused person's race,
- 16 color, disability, religion, national origin or ancestry, age,
- 17 gender, sexual orientation, or gender identity.
- 18 (b) If a falsely accused person prevails in an action
- 19 brought under Subsection (a), the person may recover attorney's
- 20 fees and costs incurred in bringing the action.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 100B.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 22 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that
- 23 accrues on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
