A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the prosecution of the offense of cruelty to
- 3 nonlivestock animals.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.092, Penal Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally,
- 9 knowingly, [or with criminal negligence:
- 10 (1) tortures an animal or in a cruel manner kills or
- 11 causes serious bodily injury to an animal;
- 12 (2) without the owner's effective consent, kills,
- 13 administers poison to, or causes serious bodily injury to an
- 14 animal;
- 15 (3) fails unreasonably to provide necessary food,
- 16 water, care, or shelter for an animal in the person's custody;
- 17 (4) abandons unreasonably an animal in the person's
- 18 custody;
- 19 (5) transports or confines an animal in a cruel
- 20 manner;
- 21 (6) without the owner's effective consent, causes
- 22 bodily injury to an animal;
- 23 (7) causes one animal to fight with another animal, if
- 24 either animal is not a dog;

- 1 (8) uses a live animal as a lure in dog race training
- 2 or in dog coursing on a racetrack; or
- 3 (9) seriously overworks an animal.
- 4 (d-1) It is a defense to prosecution for alleged criminal
- 5 negligence that the conduct occurred during the actual discharge of
- 6 the actor's duties while employed as a veterinarian licensed under
- 7 Chapter 801, Occupations Code, or as a person assisting the
- 8 veterinarian.
- 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 12 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 13 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 14 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 15 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 16 before that date.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
