- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 46B.084(d-1), Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d-1) This article does not require the criminal case to be
- 8 finally resolved within any specific period, except that, in a
- 9 jurisdiction to which Subsection (d)(1) applies, a pretrial hearing
- 10 on any evidentiary or procedural issue that must be resolved for the
- 11 criminal proceedings in the case to proceed to trial or another
- 12 resolution must be conducted not later than the 14th day after the
- 13 date of the court's determination under this article that the
- 14 <u>defendant's competency has been restored</u>.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
