- 5 SECTION 1. Section 134.004(b), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Grants may be awarded under this chapter from the Jobs
- 8 and Education for Texans (JET) fund:
- 9 (1) to defray the start-up costs associated with the
- 10 development of new career and technical education programs at
- 11 public junior colleges, public technical institutes, public state
- 12 colleges, and school districts and open-enrollment charter schools
- 13 described under Section 134.007 that meet the requirements of
- 14 Section 134.006; and
- 15 (2) to pay costs for the acquisition, implementation,
- 16 and ongoing maintenance of technology solutions necessary to
- 17 support programs described by Subdivision (1).
- SECTION 2. Section 134.006(b), Education Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (b) A grant received under this section may be used only:
- 21 (1) to support courses or programs that prepare
- 22 students for career employment in occupations that are identified
- 23 by local businesses as being in high demand, including courses
- 24 offered for dual credit;

- 1 (2) to finance initial costs of career and technical
- 2 education course or program development, including the costs of
- 3 constructing or renovating facilities, purchasing equipment, and
- 4 other expenses associated with the development of a new course;
- 5 [and]
- 6 (3) to finance a career and technical education course
- 7 or program that leads to a license, certificate, or postsecondary
- 8 degree; and
- 9 (4) to finance the acquisition, implementation, and
- 10 ongoing maintenance of technology solutions necessary to support a
- 11 course or program described by Subdivision (1), (2), or (3).
- 12 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to a grant awarded on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
