- 15 (3) enforcement of prohibitions on the sale of tickets
- 16 to or by an individual younger than 18 years of age; and
- 17 (4) enforcement of prohibitions on a person playing or
- 18 <u>facilitating the play of</u> a lottery game by telephone <u>or through an</u>
- 19 Internet application or mobile Internet application in violation of
- 20 <u>Section 466.318</u>.
