14	(b) Notwithstanding Section 49.062, if the board of a
15	district to which this section applies conducts meetings at least
16	quarterly, the board shall conduct a meeting at least once per
17	quarter at a designated meeting location:
18	(1) inside the district; or
19	(2) within 10 miles of the boundary of the district.
20	(c) Notwithstanding Chapter 551, Government Code, and
21	except as provided by this subsection, a district to which this
22	section applies may satisfy the requirements of Subsection (b) of
23	this section by conducting quarterly meetings by telephone
24	conference call or video conference call. A meeting to discuss the

1 tax rate of the district must be conducted in person.
