5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Title 6, Business & Commerce Code, is amended by
7	adding Chapter 205 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 205. REGULATION OF PRIVATE FIREARM TRANSFERS
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 205.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Firearm" has the meaning assigned by Section
12	46.01, Penal Code.
13	(2) "Licensed firearms dealer" means a person who is
14	licensed as a firearms dealer under 18 U.S.C. Section 923.
15	SUBCHAPTER B. REGULATION OF PRIVATE FIREARM TRANSFERS
16	Sec. 205.051. REQUIREMENTS FOR PRIVATE FIREARM TRANSFER;
17	OFFENSE. (a) A person may not sell or otherwise transfer a firearm
18	to another person unless:
19	(1) the person is a licensed firearms dealer; or
20	(2) the person is not a licensed firearms dealer, and:
21	(A) the person sells or transfers the firearm to
22	a licensed firearms dealer;
23	(B) the transferor and the transferee are related
24	within the first degree by consanguinity or affinity as determined

- 1 <u>under Chapter 573</u>, Government Code; or
- 2 (C) before delivering the firearm to the person
- 3 to whom the firearm is being sold or transferred, the person selling
- 4 or transferring the firearm requests that a licensed firearms
- 5 dealer conduct, in the manner required by 18 U.S.C. Section 922, a
- 6 national instant criminal background check to verify that the
- 7 person to whom the firearm is being sold or transferred may lawfully
- 8 possess a firearm.
- 9 (b) A person who violates this section commits an offense.
- 10 An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 11 Sec. 205.052. DUTIES OF LICENSED FIREARMS DEALER. (a) If a
- 12 licensed firearms dealer receives a request to conduct a national
- instant criminal background check under Section 205.051(a)(2)(C),
- 14 the dealer shall:
- 15 (1) in the manner required by 18 U.S.C. Section 922,
- 16 conduct the criminal background check to verify that the person to
- 17 whom the firearm is being sold or transferred may lawfully possess a
- 18 firearm; and
- 19 (2) notify the person who is selling or transferring
- 20 the firearm of the results of the criminal background check.
- 21 (b) A licensed firearms dealer who performs a national
- 22 instant criminal background check under this section may collect a
- 23 reasonable fee from the person who requests the criminal background
- 24 check.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
