4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 48.052(a), Education Code, is amended to

6 read as follows:

7 (a) Notwithstanding Section 48.051, a school district that

8 has fewer than 350 [130] students in average daily attendance shall

9 be provided a basic allotment on the basis of $\underline{350}$ [$\underline{130}$] students in

average daily attendance if it offers a kindergarten through grade

11 12 program and has preceding or current year's average daily

12 attendance of at least 90 students or is 30 miles or more by bus

13 route from the nearest high school district. A district offering a

14 kindergarten through grade 8 program whose preceding or current

15 year's average daily attendance was at least 50 students or which is

16 30 miles or more by bus route from the nearest high school district

17 shall be provided a basic allotment on the basis of 75 students in

18 average daily attendance. An average daily attendance of 60

19 students shall be the basis of providing the basic allotment if a

20 district offers a kindergarten through grade 6 program and has

21 preceding or current year's average daily attendance of at least 40

22 students or is 30 miles or more by bus route from the nearest high

23 school district.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
