## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a notarized affidavit requesting a municipal animal
3	control authority to seize and impound a dangerous or aggressive
4	dog in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 822, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 822.008 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 822.008. NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT REQUESTING MUNICIPAL
9	ANIMAL CONTROL AUTHORITY TO OPERATE IN EXTRATERRITORIAL
10	JURISDICTION. (a) In this section, "aggressive dog" means a dog
11	that makes an unprovoked attack on a domestic animal or livestock
12	<pre>that:</pre>
13	(1) causes bodily injury to the animal or livestock;
14	<u>and</u>
15	(2) occurs in a place other than an enclosure:
16	(A) in which the dog was being kept; and
17	(B) that is reasonably secured to prevent the dog
18	from leaving the enclosure.
19	(b) A municipal animal control authority in the
20	municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction may seize and impound
21	a dangerous or aggressive dog until a court orders its disposition
22	<u>if:</u>
23	(1) the authority receives a notarized affidavit
24	signed by at least two residents from different households in the

- 1 extraterritorial jurisdiction requesting assistance from the
- 2 authority and alleging that:
- 3 (A) a dangerous or aggressive dog has repeatedly
- 4 attacked humans, domestic animals, or livestock within the
- 5 extraterritorial jurisdiction; and
- 6 (B) due to the presence of a dangerous or
- 7 aggressive dog, the extraterritorial jurisdiction is an unsafe
- 8 environment for humans, domestic animals, or livestock; and
- 9 (2) in the extraterritorial jurisdiction:
- 10 (A) no animal control authority is authorized to
- 11 operate; or
- 12 <u>(B) the operating animal control authority does</u>
- 13 not provide for the seizure or impoundment of dangerous or
- 14 aggressive dogs.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
