A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the eligibility of certain counties to participate in
- 3 the rural sheriff's office salary assistance grant program and the
- 4 rural prosecutor's office salary assistance grant program.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 130.911(a)(2), Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (2) "Qualified county" means a county with a
- 9 population of 400,000 [300,000] or less.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 130.911(d), Local Government Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (d) The comptroller shall award a grant to a qualified
- 13 county that applies for the grant using money appropriated to the
- 14 comptroller for that purpose. The grant must be in the following
- 15 applicable amount:
- 16 (1) \$250,000 if the county has a population of less
- 17 than 10,000;
- 18 (2) \$350,000 if the county has a population of 10,000
- 19 or more and less than 50,000; [ex]
- 20 (3) \$500,000 if the county has a population of 50,000
- 21 or more and less than 300,000; or
- 22 (4) \$650,000 if the county has a population of 300,000
- 23 or more and 400,000 or less.
- SECTION 3. Section 130.913(a)(2), Local Government Code, is

- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 (2) "Qualified prosecutor's office" means, in a
- 3 jurisdiction with a population of 400,000 [300,000] or less, the
- 4 office of a district attorney, criminal district attorney, or
- 5 county attorney with criminal prosecution duties.
- 6 SECTION 4. Sections 130.913(d) and (e), Local Government
- 7 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (d) The comptroller shall award a grant to a qualified
- 9 prosecutor's office that applies for the grant using money
- 10 appropriated to the comptroller for that purpose. The grant must be
- 11 in the following applicable amount:
- 12 (1) \$100,000 if the prosecutor's office's jurisdiction
- 13 has a population of less than 10,000;
- 14 (2) \$175,000 if the prosecutor's office's jurisdiction
- 15 has a population of 10,000 or more and less than 50,000; [or]
- 16 (3) \$275,000 if the prosecutor's office's jurisdiction
- 17 has a population of 50,000 or more and less than 300,000; or
- 18 (4) \$375,000 if the prosecutor's office's jurisdiction
- 19 has a population of 300,000 or more and 400,000 or less.
- 20 (e) A prosecutor's office that is awarded a grant shall use
- 21 or authorize the use of the grant money only:
- 22 (1) to increase the salary of an assistant attorney,
- 23 an investigator, <u>a paralegal</u>, or a victim assistance coordinator
- 24 employed at the office; or
- 25 (2) to hire additional staff for the office.
- 26 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
