5	SECTION 1. Section 437.001(7), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(7) " <u>Honey</u> [Small honey] production operation" means a

9	[(A) produces less than 2,500 pounds of honey

11	[(B)] sells or distributes [the] honey or
12	honeycomb [that] the beekeeper produces [either personally or with
13	the help of the beekeeper's immediate family members;
14	[(C) only sells or distributes honey or
15	honeycomb:
16	[(i) that is produced from a hive that is:
17	[(a) located in the state; and
18	[(b) owned and managed by the
19	beekeeper;
20	[(ii)] that is <u>or from which is extracted</u>
21	pure honey as defined by Section 131.001, Agriculture Code, [and]
22	that is raw and not blended with any other product or otherwise
23	adulterated[; and

1 beekeeper's home, a farmer's market, a farm stand, or a municipal, 2 county, or nonprofit fair, festival, or event; and

3 [(D) delivers the honey or honeycomb that the 4 beekeeper produces to the consumer at the point of sale or another 5 location designated by the consumer].

6 SECTION 2. Sections 437.0197, 437.0198, and 437.0199, 7 Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 437.0197. EXEMPTION FOR [SMALL] HONEY PRODUCTION 9 OPERATION. A [small] honey production operation is not a food 10 service establishment for purposes of this chapter.

11 Sec. 437.0198. REGULATION OF [SMALL] HONEY PRODUCTION 12 OPERATION PROHIBITED. A local government authority, including a 13 local health department, may not regulate the production of honey 14 or honeycomb at a [small] honey production operation.

Sec. 437.0199. LABELING REQUIREMENTS FOR [SMALL] HONEY PRODUCTION OPERATION. Honey or honeycomb sold or distributed by a [small] honey production operation must be labeled in accordance with Subchapter E, Chapter 131, Agriculture Code. [The label must include:

20 [(1) the net weight of the honey expressed in both the 21 avoirdupois and metric systems;

[(2) the beekeeper's name and address; and

23 [(3) the statement "Bottled or packaged in a facility

24 not inspected by the Texas Department of State Health Services."]

25 SECTION 3. Chapter 437, Health and Safety Code, is amended 26 by adding Section 437.01991 to read as follows:

27 <u>Sec. 437.01991. HONEY AS RAW AGRICULT</u>URAL COMMODITY. (a)

1	In this section, "raw agricultural commodity" has the meaning
2	assigned by Section 431.002.
3	(b) For purposes of this subtitle and other applicable law,
4	a honey production operation that:
5	(1) extracts honey from honeycomb is harvesting a raw
6	agricultural commodity; and
7	(2) bottles extracted honey and packages cut honeycomb
8	is packaging a raw agricultural commodity without necessitating any
9	additional manufacturing or processing.

10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
