- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.310 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.310. ECONOMICS. (a) In this section, "institution
- 9 of higher education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 10 (b) An institution of higher education may not award an
- 11 associate or baccalaureate degree to any person unless the person
- 12 has credit for at least three semester credit hours or the
- 13 equivalent for a course in economics that dedicates equal time to
- 14 macroeconomics and microeconomics.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 51.310, Education Code, as added by this
- 16 Act, applies only to a student who enrolls in an associate or
- 17 baccalaureate degree program at a public institution of higher
- 18 education on or after January 1, 2026.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
