4 audio recording of each meeting described by Subdivision (1) on the

6 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 7 an open meeting held on or after the effective date of this Act. An 8 open meeting that is held before the effective date of this Act is 9 governed by the law in effect on the date of the open meeting, and 10 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
