- 2 relating to the disclosure of appraisal methods by automobile
- 3 insurers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 1952, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1952.308 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1952.308. DISCLOSURE OF APPRAISAL METHODS ON REQUEST.
- 8 (a) This section applies to an insurer writing automobile
- 9 insurance in this state, including an insurance company,
- 10 corporation, reciprocal or interinsurance exchange, mutual
- 11 insurance company, capital stock company, association, county
- 12 mutual insurance company, Lloyd's plan, and any other insurer.
- (b) On request of a person whose vehicle is being appraised
- 14 by an insurer for the amount of loss, the insurer shall provide to
- 15 the person a written explanation of any procedures, formulas,
- 16 calculations, or other methods used by its appraisers to determine
- 17 the amount of loss, including the cost of observed or predicted
- 18 repairs and the salvage value of the automobile.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 1952.308, Insurance Code, as added by
- 20 this Act, applies only to an insurance policy that is delivered,
- 21 issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2026.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
