A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the affidavit form for claiming an exemption from

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 161.0041(d) and (e), Health and Safety
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The department shall develop a blank affidavit form <u>for</u>
- 8 use in claiming an exemption from a required immunization and make
- 9 that form available on the department's Internet website and in all
- 10 public schools [that contains a seal or other security device to
- 11 prevent reproduction of the form]. The affidavit form shall contain
- 12 a statement indicating that the person or, if a minor, the person's
- 13 parent, managing conservator, or guardian understands the benefits
- 14 and risks of immunizations and the benefits and risks of not being
- 15 immunized.
- 16 (e) The department shall maintain a record of the total
- 17 number of times an affidavit form was accessed on the department's
- 18 <u>Internet website</u> [forms sent out] each year and shall report that
- 19 information to the legislature each year. The department may not
- 20 maintain a record of the names of individuals who download or access
- 21 [request] an affidavit form under this section.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 161.0041(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 23 repealed.
- 24 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date

- 1 of this Act, the Department of State Health Services shall modify
- 2 the immunization exemption affidavit form as required by Section
- 3 161.0041, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
