## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the offering of certain high school courses for which

- 3 students may earn college credit.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.009, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-6) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-6) A governmental entity or state officer may not
- 8 prohibit a course or any instructional component of a course from
- 9 being offered at a high school if an accredited institution of
- 10 higher education in this state awards course credit in the subject
- 11 for the achievement of a required score on a College-Level
- 12 Examination Program examination, an advanced placement test, or an
- 13 <u>international baccalaureate examination.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 15 school year.

- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
