A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the Medicaid eligibility of certain women following a 3 pregnancy. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.024(1-1), Human Resources Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 (1-1) The commission shall continue to provide medical 7 assistance to a woman who is eligible for medical assistance for 8 9 pregnant women for a period of not less than $\underline{24}$ [+ [(1) six] months following the last month of the 10 woman's pregnancy [date the woman delivers or experiences an 11 12 involuntary miscarriage; and 13 [(2) 12 months that begins on the last day of the 14 woman's pregnancy and ends on the last day of the month in which the 12-month period ends in accordance with Section 1902(e)(16), Social 15 Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396a(e)(16))]. 16 17 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 18 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 19 20 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 21 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the waiver or authorization is granted. 22

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
