- 7 (2) gifts, grants, including federal grants, and other
- 8 donations received for the grant fund; and
- 9 (3) interest earned on the investment of money in the
- 10 grant fund.
- 11 (d) The grant fund may be used by the department only to:
- 12 (1) award grants under this section; and
- 13 (2) administer the grant program under this section.
- 14 (e) Section 403.0956 does not apply to the grant fund.
