H.B. No. 784

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to a grant program for municipal pedestrian infrastructure  
3 administered by the Texas Department of Housing and Community  
4 Affairs.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter K, Chapter 2306,  
7 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

8 SUBCHAPTER K. HOUSING AND INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMS

9 SECTION 2. Subchapter K, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is  
10 amended by adding Section 2306.2595 to read as follows:

11 Sec. 2306.2595. PEDESTRIAN INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM. (a) In  
12 this section:

13 (1) "Grant" means financial assistance that is awarded  
14 in the form of money to a municipality for a specific purpose and  
15 that is not required to be repaid. For purposes of this section,  
16 the term includes a forgivable loan.

17 (2) "Grant fund" means the pedestrian infrastructure  
18 grant fund.

19 (b) The department shall award grants to municipalities to  
20 construct pedestrian infrastructure related to sidewalks, curbs,  
21 or pedestrian lighting. The department may only award a grant under  
22 a contract between the department and a grant recipient that  
23 includes provisions under which the department is given sufficient  
24 control to ensure the public purpose of protecting the safety of the

1 public is accomplished and the state receives the return benefit.

2 (c) The grant fund is a dedicated account in the general  
3 revenue fund and consists of:

4 (1) appropriations of money to the grant fund by the  
5 legislature;

6 (2) gifts, grants, including federal grants, and other  
7 donations received for the grant fund; and

8 (3) interest earned on the investment of money in the  
9 grant fund.

10 (d) The grant fund may be used by the department only to:

11 (1) award grants under this section; and

12 (2) administer the grant program under this section.

13 (e) Section [403.0956](#) does not apply to the grant fund.

14 (f) The department shall adopt rules necessary to  
15 administer this section.

16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
