- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 26.009, Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 26.009. CONSENT REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN ACTIVITIES. (a)
- 9 In this section:
- 10 (1) "Psychological or psychiatric examination or
- 11 test" means a method designed to elicit information regarding an
- 12 attitude, habit, trait, opinion, belief, feeling, or mental
- 13 disorder or a condition thought to lead to a mental disorder,
- 14 regardless of the manner in which the method is presented or
- 15 characterized, including a method that is presented or
- 16 characterized as a survey, check-in, or screening or is embedded in
- 17 an academic lesson.
- 18 (2) "Psychological or psychiatric treatment" means
- 19 the planned, systematic use of a method or technique that is
- 20 designed to affect behavioral, emotional, or attitudinal
- 21 characteristics of an individual or group.
- 22 <u>(b)</u> An employee <u>or contractor</u> of a school district must
- 23 obtain the written, signed consent of a child's parent for each
- 24 separate activity described by this subsection in which the child

- 1 will participate before the employee or contractor may:
- 2 (1) conduct a psychological or psychiatric
- 3 examination $or[\tau]$ test $[\tau]$ or psychological or psychiatric
- 4 treatment with respect to the child, unless the examination, test,
- 5 or treatment is required under Section 38.004 or state or federal
- 6 law regarding requirements for special education; or
- 7 (2) <u>subject to Subsection (c)</u>, make or authorize the
- 8 making of a videotape of a child or record or authorize the
- 9 recording of a child's voice.
- 10 <u>(c)</u> [(b)] An employee <u>or contractor</u> of a school district is
- 11 not required to obtain the consent of a child's parent before the
- 12 employee or contractor may make a videotape of a child or authorize
- 13 the recording of a child's voice if the videotape or voice recording
- 14 is to be used only for:
- 15 (1) purposes of safety, including the maintenance of
- 16 order and discipline in common areas of the school or on school
- 17 buses;
- 18 (2) a purpose related to a cocurricular or
- 19 extracurricular activity;
- 20 (3) a purpose related to regular classroom
- 21 instruction;
- 22 (4) media coverage of the school; or
- 23 (5) a purpose related to the promotion of student
- 24 safety under Section 29.022.
- 25 <u>(d) A school district shall retain every consent of a</u>
- 26 child's parent obtained under this section as part of the child's
- 27 education records.

- 1 (e) Nothing in this section may be construed to:
- 2 (1) require an employee or contractor of a school
- 3 district to obtain the written consent of a child's parent before
- 4 verbally asking the child about the child's general well-being;
- 5 (2) affect a child's consent to counseling under
- 6 Section 32.004, Family Code; or
- 7 (3) affect the duty to report child abuse or neglect
- 8 under Chapter 261, Family Code, or an investigation of a report of
- 9 abuse or neglect under that chapter.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 11 school year.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
