3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 1355.001(3), Insurance Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(3) "Autism spectrum disorder" means <u>:</u>
7	(A) a neurobiological disorder that
8	significantly affects verbal communication, nonverbal
9	communication, and social interaction and that meets the diagnostic
10	criteria for autism spectrum disorder specified by the Diagnostic
11	and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, 5th edition, or a later
12	edition; or
13	(B) a diagnosis of [includes] autism, Asperger's
14	syndrome, or Pervasive Developmental DisorderNot Otherwise
15	Specified made using a previous edition of the Diagnostic and
16	Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders.
17	SECTION 2. Sections 1355.015(a-1) and (c-1), Insurance
18	Code, are amended to read as follows:
19	(a-1) At a minimum, a health benefit plan must provide
20	coverage for treatment of autism spectrum disorder as provided by
21	this section to an enrollee who is diagnosed with autism spectrum
22	disorder from the date of diagnosis[$ frac{1}{7}$ only if the diagnosis was in
23	place prior to the child's 10th birthday].
24	(c-1) The health benefit plan <u>may</u> [is] not <u>limit</u> [required

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1 to provide] coverage under Subsection (b) for benefits for an 2 enrollee [10 years of age or older for applied behavior analysis in 3 an amount that exceeds \$36,000 per year].

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2026. A health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2026, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
