5	SECTION 1. Section 481.037, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 481.037. <u>DESIGNATION</u> OF CERTAIN SUBSTANCES
8	[CARISOPRODOL]. Schedule IV includes <u>:</u>
9	<u>(1)</u> carisoprodol <u>;</u>
10	(2) mifepristone; and
11	(3) misoprostol.
12	SECTION 2. Section 481.111, Health and Safety Code, is
13	amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
14	(g) The provisions of this chapter relating to the
15	possession of mifepristone and misoprostol do not apply to a
16	pregnant woman who possesses mifepristone or misoprostol for her
17	own consumption.
18	SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
19	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
20	An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
21	governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
22	and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
23	purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
24	effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred

1 before that date.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
