- (a) The board of trustees of a school district shall adopt a policy 8
- 9 providing that a classroom teacher who has been employed by the
- district for fewer than 12 months or who worked fewer than 1,250 10
- hours during the 12-month period preceding the beginning of the 11
- leave under this section is eligible to take a parental leave of 12
- absence not to exceed 12 weeks in accordance with this section if 13
- the teacher has been employed as a classroom teacher by any district 14
- in this state for at least 12 months and at least 1,250 hours during 15
- 16 the 12-month period preceding the beginning of the leave.
- (b) The classroom teacher must first use all available and 17
- applicable paid vacation and sick leave while taking the leave, and 18
- 19 the remainder of the leave is unpaid.
