- 9 TECHNOLOGY POSITIONS. (a) The classification officer shall review

- 12 <u>(1) the position titles, classifications, and</u>
- 13 <u>descriptions of work for information technology positions align</u>
- 14 closely with comparable information technology position titles,
- 15 classifications, and descriptions of work in the private sector;

- 17 (2) the job description for each information
- 18 technology position incorporates competency-based language that
- 19 emphasizes the skills and knowledge needed to successfully
- 20 accomplish the responsibilities of the position rather than degree
- 21 and certification requirements.

- 23 classification officer shall consult with and consider any

- 3 SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2026, the state's
- 4 classification officer shall prepare and submit to the governor and

- 6 summary of the initial review conducted under Section 654.0371,
- 7 Government Code, as added by this Act, and any revisions made to the
- 8 information technology positions in the position classification
- 9 plan.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
