## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the residential and commercial building codes of 3 municipalities.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 214.212(a) and (d), Local Government 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (a) To protect the public health, safety, and welfare, the
8 International Residential Code, as it existed on May 1, <u>2021</u>
9 [<del>2012</del>], is adopted as a municipal residential building code in this
10 state.

(d) A municipality may review and consider amendments made by the International Code Council to the International Residential Code after May 1, <u>2021</u> [<del>2012</del>].

SECTION 2. Sections 214.216(a) and (d), Local Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

16 (a) To protect the public health, safety, and welfare, the
17 International Building Code, as it existed on May 1, <u>2021</u> [2012], is
18 adopted as a municipal commercial building code in this state.

19 (d) A municipality may review and consider amendments made 20 by the International Code Council to the International Building 21 Code after May 1, 2021 [2012].

22 SECTION 3. (a) Sections 214.212 and 214.216, Local 23 Government Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to residential 24 or commercial construction, remodeling, alteration, enlargement,

or repair that begins under an agreement made on or after January 1, 1 2026, or that begins, in the absence of an agreement, on or after 2 that date. Residential or commercial construction, remodeling, 3 4 alteration, enlargement, or repair that begins under an agreement made before January 1, 2026, or that begins, in the absence of an 5 6 agreement, before that date is governed by the law in effect when the agreement was made or the activity began, as appropriate, and 7 8 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

9 (b) Not later than December 1, 2025, municipalities shall 10 establish rules and take other necessary actions to implement 11 Sections 214.212 and 214.216, Local Government Code, as amended by 12 this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
