(a) In 8 this section, "project" includes all work to be completed on a 9 construction project for a municipality at one location within 12 10 11 months of the date the work begins. 12 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, for a construction project contracted for an amount that is less than one percent of 13 14 the total amount of a municipality's most recently adopted budget, the municipality is not required to: 15 16 (1) ensure that the contractor is covered by workers' compensation insurance coverage; or 17 18 (2) require the contractor to obtain a performance bond. 19 20 (c) For the purpose of determining the contracted amount of a construction project under Subsection (b), a municipality may not 21 aggregate work from more than one project. 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 23 to a contract entered into on or after the effective date of this 24

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
