MEDICAL ASSISTANCE COVERAGE AND 8 REIMBURSEMENT FOR CERTAIN PERSONS REQUIRING EMERGENCY OUTPATIENT 9 DIALYSIS TREATMENT. (a) This section applies only to an individual 10 11 who: 12 (1) has end stage renal disease; and 13 (2) in accordance with Section 1903(v), Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396b(v)), is eligible for medical 14 assistance benefits if the benefits are necessary to treat an 15 16 emergency medical condition. (b) For purposes of 42 C.F.R. Section 440.255, emergency 17 services required to treat an emergency medical condition include 18 outpatient dialysis treatment provided to an individual to whom 19 this section applies at a hospital or an end stage renal disease 20 21 facility, as defined by Section 251.001, Health and Safety Code. 22 (c) The commission shall ensure that medical assistance reimbursement authorized under Section 1903(v), Social Security 23 Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396b(v)), is provided for outpatient 24

1 dialysis treatment provided to an individual to whom this section 2 applies.

3 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act 4 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 5 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 6 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 7 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 8 waiver or authorization is granted.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
