9	application and proof of citizenship as required under Subsection
10	$\underline{\text{(a-1)}}$ to the registrar of the county in which the person resides.
11	Except as provided by Subsection (e), an application must be
12	submitted by personal delivery, by mail, or by telephonic facsimile
13	machine in accordance with Sections $13.143(d)$ and $(d-2)$ .
14	(a-1) A person desiring to register to vote shall submit to
15	the registrar a copy of one of the following documents:
16	(1) a United States passport or passport card issued
17	to the person;

- 3 SECTION 2. Section 13.039(a), Election Code, is amended to

- 5 (a) On receipt of a registration application, a volunteer
- 6 deputy registrar shall review it for completeness in the
- 7 applicant's presence and verify the applicant's citizenship using
- 8 the proof of citizenship required by Section 13.002(a-1).
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026, but only
- 10 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 89th Legislature,
- 11 Regular Session, 2025, to require a person to submit proof of
- 12 citizenship to register to vote is approved by the voters. If that
- 13 amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
