- 7 Sec. 659.0111. LIMITATION ON SALARY. Notwithstanding any
- 8 other law, the taxpayer funded salary of a state officer or employee
- 9 may not exceed the amount of the salary set by the biennial

- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
- 12 by adding Section 180.011 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 180.011. LIMITATION ON SALARY FOR OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE
- 14 OF POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. (a) In this section, "political
- 15 <u>subdivision" means a county, municipality, special district,</u>
- 16 school district, junior college district, or other political

- 18 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the taxpayer funded

- SECTION 3. Section 659.0111, Government Code, and Section
- 23 180.011, Local Government Code, as added by this Act, apply only to

- 1 the effective date of this Act. A salary agreement or employment
- 2 contract entered into before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law in effect at the time the agreement or contract
- 4 was entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 5 purpose.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the state fiscal
- 7 biennium that begins September 1, 2025.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
