- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 151.3131, Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.3131. <u>FIREARMS AND RELATED ITEMS</u> [FIREARM SAFETY
- 8 EQUIPMENT]. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Ammunition" has the meaning assigned by 18 U.S.C.
- 10 Section 921(a)(17)(A).
- 11 (2) "Firearm" has the meaning assigned by 18 U.S.C.
- 12 <u>Section 921(a)(3).</u>
- 13 (3) "Firearm accessory" means an item used in
- 14 conjunction with or mounted on a firearm that is not essential to
- 15 the basic function of the firearm.
- 16 (4) "Firearm [, "firearm] safety equipment" means a
- 17 gun lock box, a gun safe, a barrel lock, a trigger lock, a firearm
- 18 safety training manual or electronic publication, or another item
- 19 designed to ensure the safe handling or storage of a firearm.
- 20 (b) The sale, storage, use, or other consumption of \underline{a}
- 21 <u>firearm</u>, a firearm accessory, ammunition, or firearm safety
- 22 equipment is exempted from the taxes imposed by this chapter.
- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 24 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this

- 1 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 2 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 3 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 4 the liability for those taxes.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
