- 7 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to a contract entered into on or after the effective date of this

- 11 entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 12 purpose.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
