- Sec. 152.011. AMOUNT SET BY COMMISSIONERS COURT. Except as provided by Sections 74.104 and 75.401, Government Code, the [The] commissioners court of a county shall set the amount of the compensation, office and travel expenses, and all other allowances
- 5 for county and precinct officers and employees who are paid wholly
- 6 from county funds.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
