A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

L	AN ACT

- 2 relating to providing free full-day prekindergarten for certain
- 3 children.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.02124(a), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Subject to Subsection (c), a parent or guardian may
- 8 elect for a student to:
- 9 (1) repeat prekindergarten;
- 10 (2) enroll in prekindergarten, if the student would
- 11 have been eligible to enroll in prekindergarten during the previous
- 12 school year under Section 29.153 [29.153(b)] and the student has
- 13 not yet enrolled in kindergarten;
- 14 (3) repeat kindergarten;
- 15 (4) enroll in kindergarten, if the student would have
- 16 been eligible to enroll in kindergarten in the previous school year
- 17 and has not yet enrolled in first grade; or
- 18 (5) for grades one through eight, repeat the grade in
- 19 which the student was enrolled during the previous school year.
- 20 SECTION 2. Sections 29.153(a-1), (c), (c-1), and (d),
- 21 Education Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a-1) A district shall offer prekindergarten classes to any
- 23 child [if the district identifies 15 or more children] who is [are
- 24 eligible under Subsection (b) and are] at least] three [four] years

- 1 of age. [A school district may offer prekindergarten classes if the
- 2 district identifies 15 or more eligible children who are at least
- 3 three years of age. A district may not charge tuition for a
- 4 prekindergarten class offered under this section.
- 5 (c) A prekindergarten class under this section [may be
- 6 operated on a half-day basis for children under four years of age
- 7 and] shall be operated on a full-day basis [for children who are at
- 8 least four years of age]. A district is not required to provide
- 9 transportation for a prekindergarten class, but transportation, if
- 10 provided, is included for funding purposes as part of the regular
- 11 transportation system.
- 12 (c-1) A prekindergarten class under this section [for
- 13 children who are least four years of age] must comply with the
- 14 program standards required for high quality prekindergarten
- 15 programs under Subchapter E-1.
- 16 (d) Subject to Subsections (d-1) and (d-2), on application
- 17 of a district, the commissioner shall exempt a district from the
- 18 application of all or any part of this section, including all or any
- 19 part of Subchapter E-1 for a prekindergarten class described by
- 20 Subsection (c-1), if the commissioner determines that [+
- 21 $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ the district would be required to construct
- 22 classroom facilities in order to provide prekindergarten classes [+
- 23 or
- 24 [(2) implementing any part of this section would result
- 25 in fewer eligible children being enrolled in a prekindergarten
- 26 class under this section].
- 27 SECTION 3. Section 29.1531(a), Education Code, is amended

- 1 to read as follows:
- 2 (a) A school district may offer on a tuition basis or use
- 3 district funds to provide[+
- 4 [(1) an additional half-day of prekindergarten
- 5 classes to children who are eligible for classes under Section
- 6 29.153 and are under four years of age; and
- 7 $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ half-day and full-day prekindergarten classes
- 8 to children not eligible for classes under Section 29.153.
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 48.005(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 (a) In this chapter, average daily attendance is:
- 12 (1) the quotient of the sum of attendance for each day
- 13 of the minimum number of days of instruction as described under
- 14 Section 25.081(a) divided by the minimum number of days of
- 15 instruction;
- 16 (2) for a district that operates under a flexible year
- 17 program under Section 29.0821, the quotient of the sum of
- 18 attendance for each actual day of instruction as permitted by
- 19 Section 29.0821(b)(1) divided by the number of actual days of
- 20 instruction as permitted by Section 29.0821(b)(1);
- 21 (3) for a district that operates under a flexible
- 22 school day program under Section 29.0822, the average daily
- 23 attendance as calculated by the commissioner in accordance with
- 24 Sections 29.0822(d) and (d-1); or
- 25 (4) for a district that operates [a half-day program
- 26 or a full-day program under Section 29.153(c), [one-half of] the
- 27 average daily attendance calculated under Subdivision (1).

- 1 SECTION 5. Sections 29.153(b), (e-1), and (f), Education
- 2 Code, are repealed.
- 3 SECTION 6. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
