1 (B) if not a member of the family of the person 2 with a mental illness or developmental or intellectual disability, 3 has the permission of the family head or legal guardian of the 4 person with a mental illness or developmental or intellectual 5 disability to take the person with a mental illness or 6 developmental or intellectual disability fishing;

7 (5) who is participating in an event that is sponsored 8 or co-sponsored by the department with the approval of the 9 director; [or]

10 (6) who is a resident and who is a veteran of the 11 United States armed forces, if the person is acting under Section 12 11.208 and complying with rules adopted under that section; or

13 (7) who is a resident 70 years of age or older and who
14 is engaged in fishing in the public water of this state.

15 SECTION 2. The Parks and Wildlife Department is not 16 required to issue a refund to a person described by Section 17 46.002(a)(7), Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act, for a 18 fishing license, stamp, or package issued to the person before the 19 effective date of this Act.
