- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 48.151(b)(1), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1) "Regular eligible student" means a student who:
- 9 (A) resides two or more miles from the student's
- 10 campus of regular attendance, $\underline{\text{regardless}}$ of whether the student
- 11 <u>resides in the attendance zone of that campus,</u> measured along the
- 12 shortest route that may be traveled on public roads, and who is not
- 13 classified as a student eligible for special education services; or
- 14 (B) is a homeless child or youth, as defined by 42
- 15 U.S.C. Section 11434a.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
