A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to emergency generators or other power sources for nursing
3	facilities and assisted living facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 242, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Sections 242.053 and 242.054 to read as
- 7 follows:

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- 8 Sec. 242.053. EMERGENCY GENERATOR OR OTHER POWER SOURCE.
- 9 (a) Each nursing facility licensed under this chapter shall ensure
- 10 the facility is equipped with an operational emergency generator or
- 11 comparable emergency power source and a sufficient amount of fuel
- 12 to operate the generator or power source during a power outage for a
- 13 minimum of 72 hours in:
- 14 (1) an area in the facility of sufficient size to at
- 15 all times safely maintain residents as appropriate for resident
- 16 needs; and
- 17 (2) for a facility that maintains an installed unit
- 18 <u>locking device</u>, as defined by commission rule, to restrict a
- 19 resident's ability to exit a unit of the facility or the facility, a
- 20 separately powered area in addition to an area described by
- 21 Subdivision (1).
- (b) An operational emergency generator or comparable
- 23 <u>emergency power source required by Subsection (a)</u> may be powered by
- 24 any type of fuel, including natural gas.

- 1 (c) A nursing facility must comply with Subsection (a) not
- 2 later than September 1, 2026. A facility may submit a request to
- 3 the commission for an extension not to exceed one year to comply in
- 4 good faith with Subsection (a). A facility may not request more
- 5 than two additional one-year extensions and must separately request
- 6 each extension. This subsection expires September 1, 2029.
- 7 <u>Sec. 242.054. GENERATOR INSPECTION. (a) In addition to the</u>
- 8 <u>inspections required under Sections 242.043</u> and 242.044, the
- 9 commission shall conduct an annual inspection of each facility's
- 10 emergency generator or other power source required by Section
- 11 242.053.
- 12 (b) The executive commissioner by rule shall prescribe a
- 13 checklist for an inspection conducted under this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
- 15 Code, is amended by adding Sections 247.073 and 247.074 to read as
- 16 follows:
- 17 Sec. 247.073. EMERGENCY GENERATOR OR OTHER POWER SOURCE.
- 18 (a) Each assisted living facility licensed under this chapter
- 19 shall ensure the facility is equipped with an operational emergency
- 20 generator or comparable emergency power source and a sufficient
- 21 amount of fuel to operate the generator or power source during a
- 22 power outage for a minimum of 72 hours in:
- 23 (1) an area in the facility of sufficient size to at
- 24 all times safely maintain residents as appropriate for resident
- 25 <u>needs; and</u>
- 26 (2) for a facility that maintains an installed unit
- 27 locking device, as defined by commission rule, to restrict a

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- 1 resident's ability to exit a unit of the facility or the facility, a
- 2 separately powered area in addition to an area described by
- 3 <u>Subdivision (1).</u>
- 4 (b) An operational emergency generator or comparable
- 5 emergency power source required by Subsection (a) may be powered by
- 6 any type of fuel, including natural gas.
- 7 (c) An assisted living facility must comply with Subsection
- 8 (a) not later than September 1, 2026. A facility may submit a
- 9 request to the commission for an extension not to exceed one year to
- 10 comply in good faith with Subsection (a). A facility may not
- 11 request more than two additional one-year extensions and must
- 12 separately request each extension. This subsection expires
- 13 September 1, 2029.
- 14 Sec. 247.074. GENERATOR INSPECTION. (a) In addition to the
- 15 inspections required under Sections 247.023(a) and 247.027, the
- 16 commission shall conduct an annual inspection of each facility's
- 17 emergency generator or other power source required by Section
- 18 247.073.
- 19 (b) The executive commissioner by rule shall prescribe a
- 20 checklist for an inspection conducted under this section.
- 21 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 22 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 23 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 24 Sections 242.053, 242.054, 247.073, and 247.074, Health and Safety
- 25 Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
