4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 44.0041, Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 44.0041. PUBLICATION OF <u>LINE-ITEM</u> [SUMMARY OF
8	$\frac{PROPOSED}{PROPOSED}$] BUDGET. [$\frac{(a)}{(a)}$] Concurrently with the publication of
9	notice of the budget under Section 44.004, a school district shall
10	post the district's proposed budget in line-item form [a summary of
11	the proposed budget]:
12	(1) on the school district's Internet website; or
13	(2) if the district has no Internet website, in the
14	district's central administrative office.
15	[(b) The budget summary must include:
16	(1) information relating to per student and aggregate
17	spending on:
18	[(A) instruction;
19	[(B) instructional support;
20	[(C) central administration;
21	[(D) district operations;
22	[(E) debt service; and
23	[(F) any other category designated by the
24	commissioner; and

- 1 [(2) a comparison to the previous year's actual
- 2 spending.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 44.0051, Education Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 (a) On final approval of the budget by the board of
- 6 trustees, the school district shall post on the district's Internet
- 7 website a copy of the budget adopted by the board of trustees in
- 8 line-item form. The district's Internet website must prominently
- 9 display the electronic link to the adopted budget in line-item
- 10 form.
- 11 (b) The district shall maintain the adopted budget, in
- 12 line-item form, on the district's Internet website until the third
- 13 anniversary of the date the budget was adopted.
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 102.005(c), Local Government Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (c) The proposed budget shall be available in line-item form
- 17 for inspection by any person. If the municipality maintains an
- 18 Internet website, the municipal clerk shall take action to ensure
- 19 that the proposed budget is posted on the website in line-item form.
- SECTION 4. Section 102.008(a), Local Government Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) On final approval of the budget by the governing body of
- 23 the municipality, the governing body shall:
- 24 (1) file the budget with the municipal clerk; and
- 25 (2) if the municipality maintains an Internet website,
- 26 take action to ensure that:
- 27 (A) a copy of the budget, including the cover

- 1 page, is posted on the website in line-item form; and
- 2 (B) the record vote described by Section
- 3 102.007(d)(2) is posted on the website at least until the first
- 4 anniversary of the date the budget is adopted.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
