- 5 SECTION 1. Section 572.032, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Financial statements filed under this subchapter are
- 9 public records. The commission shall:
- 10 (1) maintain the statements in separate alphabetical
- 11 files and in a manner that is accessible to the public during
- 12 regular office hours; and
- 13 (2) make each statement available to the public on the
- 14 commission's Internet website not later than the 15th day after the
- 15 date the statement is required to be filed or the date the statement
- 16 is actually filed, whichever date is later.
- 17 (d) The commission is not required to continue to make
- 18 <u>available</u> on the commission's Internet website a financial
- 19 statement that the commission may destroy under Subsection (c).
- 20 The commission may not make available on the commission's Internet
- 21 website a financial statement that the commission is required to
- 22 destroy under Subsection (c).
- SECTION 2. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, as
- 24 amended by Chapters 34 (S.B. 1576) and 983 (H.B. 776), Acts of the

- 1 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is reenacted and amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 (a-1) The commission shall remove the home address, the
- 4 telephone number, and the names of the dependent children of an
- 5 individual from a financial statement filed by the individual under
- 6 this subchapter before:
- 7 (1) permitting a member of the public to view the
- 8 statement;
- 9 (2) providing a copy of the statement to a member of
- 10 the public; or
- 11 (3) making the statement available to the public on
- 12 the commission's Internet website[, if the commission makes
- 13 statements filed under this subchapter available on its website].
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 572.032(b), Government Code, is
- 15 repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
