## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the days and hours during which the polls are open for
- 3 early voting by personal appearance.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.004(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) The [If early voting by personal appearance is required
- 8 to be conducted for extended hours under Section 85.005(c) or for
- 9 weekend hours under Section 85.006(e), the] registrar's office
- 10 shall remain open for providing voter registration information
- 11 during the [extended hours or weekend] hours that the main early
- 12 voting polling place is open for voting.
- SECTION 2. Sections 85.001(a) and (e), Election Code, are
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The period for early voting by personal appearance
- 16 begins on the 17th day before election day and continues through the
- 17 fourth day before election day, except as otherwise provided by
- 18 this <u>subchapter</u> [section].
- 19 (e) For an election held on the uniform election date in May
- 20 and any resulting runoff election, the period for early voting by
- 21 personal appearance begins on the 12th day before election day and
- 22 continues through the fourth day before election day, except as
- 23 otherwise provided by this subchapter.
- SECTION 3. Section 85.006, Election Code, is amended to

- 1 read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 85.006. EXTENDED VOTING [ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY]. (a)
- 3 Except as provided by Subsection (b), the authority ordering an
- 4 election may order early voting by personal appearance at the main
- 5 early voting polling place to be conducted:
- $\underline{\text{(1)}}$  on one or more Saturdays or Sundays during the
- 7 early voting period; or
- 8 (2) during an extended early voting period beginning
- 9 the 19th day before election day and continuing for any number of
- 10 consecutive days up to and including the third day before election
- 11 day.
- 12 (b) In an election in which a county clerk is the early
- 13 voting clerk under Section 83.002, only the early voting clerk may
- 14 order  $\underline{\text{extended}}$  voting  $[\underline{\text{on a Saturday or Sunday}}]$ . The clerk must do
- 15 so by written order.
- 16 (c) Except as otherwise provided by this section, the [The]
- 17 authority ordering extended voting [on a Saturday or Sunday] shall
- 18 determine the hours during which voting is to be conducted.
- 19 (d) The authority authorized to order <u>extended</u> early voting
- 20 [on a Saturday or Sunday] under Subsection (a) or (b) shall order
- 21 [the] voting on a Saturday or Sunday under the applicable
- 22 subsection on receipt of a written request submitted by at least 15
- 23 registered voters of the territory covered by the election. The
- 24 request must be submitted in time to enable compliance with Section
- 25 85.007. The authority is not required to order the voting on a
- 26 particular date specified by the request but shall order the voting
- 27 on at least one Saturday if a Saturday is requested and on at least

- 1 one Sunday if a Sunday is requested.
- 2 (e) In a primary election or the general election for state
- 3 and county officers, the early voting clerk shall order voting by
- 4 personal appearance at the main early voting polling place to be
- 5 conducted on the last Saturday of the early voting period for at
- 6 least 12 consecutive hours, except that voting may not be conducted
- 7 earlier than 6 a.m. or later than 10 p.m., and on the last Sunday of
- 8 the early voting period for at least six consecutive hours, except
- 9 that voting may not be conducted earlier than 9 a.m. or later than
- 10 10 p.m. This subsection supersedes any provision of this
- 11 subchapter to the extent of any conflict.
- 12 <u>(f) An authority authorized to order extended early voting</u>
- 13 under Subsection (a) or (b) that orders the voting during an
- 14 extended early voting period shall order personal appearance voting
- 15 at the main early voting polling place to be conducted for at least
- 16 12 hours on any weekday or Saturday and for at least five hours on
- 17 any Sunday of the extended early voting period.
- SECTION 4. Sections 85.007(a) and (b), Election Code, are
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- 20 (a) The election order and the election notice must state:
- 21 (1) the date that early voting will begin if under
- 22 Section 85.001(d) the early voting period is to begin later than the
- 23 prescribed date;
- 24 (2) the regular dates and hours that voting will be
- 25 conducted under Section 85.005(b); and
- 26 (3) the dates and hours that extended voting [on
- 27 Saturday or Sunday or ordered to be conducted under Section

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1 85.006(a).
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- 2 (b) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each
- 3 election stating the dates and hours that extended voting [on a
- 4 Saturday or Sunday] is ordered to be conducted under Section
- 5 85.006(b).
- 6 SECTION 5. Section 85.064(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (d) The authority authorized under Section 85.006 to order
- 9 extended early voting [on a Saturday or Sunday] may also order, in
- 10 the manner prescribed by that section, extended early voting to be
- 11 conducted [on a Saturday or Sunday] at any one or more of the
- 12 temporary branch polling places. In addition, the early voting
- 13 clerk shall order such voting in accordance with Section 85.006(e)
- 14 at each temporary branch polling place established under Section
- 15 85.062(d).
- SECTION 6. Section 85.068(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 (a) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each
- 19 election stating any dates and the hours that <u>extended</u> voting [on
- 20 Saturday or Sunday] will be conducted under Section 85.064(d), if
- 21 the early voting clerk is a county clerk or city secretary under
- 22 Section 83.002 or 83.005.
- 23 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
