- 9 SECTION 2. Section 22.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a [A] school
- 13 district employee is entitled to have an amount deducted from the
- 14 employee's salary for membership fees or dues to a professional
- 15 organization. The employee must:
- 16 (1) file with the district a signed written request
- 17 identifying the organization and specifying the number of pay
- 18 periods per year the deductions are to be made; and
- 19 (2) inform the district of the total amount of the fees
- 20 and dues for each year or have the organization notify the district
- 21 of the amount.
- 22 <u>(d) A school district may not deduct or withhold, or</u>
- 23 contract to deduct or withhold, from a classroom teacher's salary
- 24 or wages payment of membership fees or dues to a labor organization
