The term does not include: 12 (A) a grave, marker, monument, tombstone, crypt, niche, plot, or lawn crypt unless it is sold in contemplation of 13 trade for a funeral service or funeral merchandise to which this 14 chapter applies; or 15 16 (B) a transportation protection agreement. (15) "Transportation protection agreement" means an 17 agreement to pay for transportation of a body from the place of 18 death to a licensed holding facility or licensed crematory, if the 19 place of death is more than 75 miles from the location of the 20 licensed facility that will provide the funeral services. 21 SECTION 2. Section 154.151, Finance Code, is amended by 22 23 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows: 24 (f) A transportation protection agreement is not considered
