- On payment of the prescribed fee, an applicant for motor 8
- vehicle registration shall be issued a license plate or set of 9
- plates, provided that the department must issue a set of two plates 10
- 11 to an applicant for registration of a passenger car or light truck.
- 12 (d) A rule adopted under Subsection (c) must authorize a
- passenger car or light truck to display only a rear license plate. 13
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 504.943(a), Transportation Code,
- amended to read as follows: 15
- A [Except as provided by Subsection (b), a] person 16
- commits an offense if the person operates on a public highway, 17
- during a registration period, a [motor] vehicle that does not 18
- display all [two] license plates required by this chapter or a rule 19
- adopted under this chapter to be displayed on the vehicle that: 20
- 21 (1) have been assigned by the department for
- 22 period; and
- 23 (2) comply with department rules regarding
- 24 placement of license plates.

- SECTION 3. Section 504.943(b), Transportation Code, is
- 2 repealed.
- 3 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 8 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 10 before that date.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
