6	SECTION 1. Section 1.06, Tax Code, is amended to read as
7	follows:
8	Sec. 1.06. EFFECT OF WEEKEND <u>,</u> [ <del>OR</del> ] HOLIDAY <u>, OR OFFICE</u>
9	CLOSURE. An act is timely if:
10	<u>(1)</u> [ <del>If</del> ] the last day for the performance of <u>the</u> [ <del>an</del> ]
11	act is:
12	(A) a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state or
13	national holiday <u>; or</u>
14	(B) in the case of a payment of taxes imposed by a
15	taxing unit, a day on which the office of the collector for the
16	taxing unit is closed; and
17	(2) $[\tau]$ the act is $[timely if]$ performed on the next
18	regular business day.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026.
