- 18 (h-1) If a [A] community-based organization that applies
- for funding under Subsection (h) provides [providing] services 19
- regulated by the state, the organization shall provide to the 20
- 21 commission evidence of any certification, license, or registration

- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to an application for money from the skills development fund
