6	SECTION 1. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
7	adding Section 493.036 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 493.036. HOUSING IN PRIVATE FACILITY PROHIBITED. (a)
9	Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by Subsection
10	(b), the department may not house or confine in a facility owned,
11	operated, or managed by a private vendor, including on a temporary
12	basis:
13	(1) an inmate sentenced to imprisonment in the
14	department;
15	(2) an inmate described by Section 507.002; or
16	(3) a person described by Section 493.009(a).
17	(b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a residential
18	correctional facility as defined by Section 508.157.
19	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 495, Government Code, is
20	amended by adding Section 495.0011 to read as follows:
21	Sec. 495.0011. CERTAIN CONTRACTS PROHIBITED. (a)
22	Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by Subsection
23	(b), the board may not enter into a contract under which an inmate
24	sentenced to imprisonment in the department, an inmate described by

Section 507.002, or a person described by Section 493.009(a) will be housed or confined in a facility owned, operated, or managed by a private vendor.

4 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a contract relating to
5 a residential correctional facility as defined by Section 508.157.

6 SECTION 3. Section 493.036, Government Code, as added by 7 this Act, applies to the housing or confinement of a person 8 described by that section on or after the effective date of this 9 Act, regardless of whether the offense for which the person is 10 housed or confined occurred before, on, or after the effective date 11 of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. Section 495.0011, Government Code, as added by 13 this Act, applies to a contract entered into or renewed on or after 14 the effective date of this Act. A contract entered into or renewed 15 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 16 effect on the date the contract was entered into or renewed, and the 17 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
